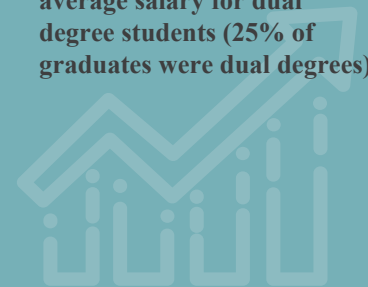

2023/2024 INITIATIVES

- Successfully implemented the SEAS Employer Advisory Council (SEAC) and employer coffee chats this year. 70 alumni and 107 students participated in the employer coffee chats.
- Increased the quality and amount of programming available to students by offering 95 career workshops/panel discussions and employer information sessions. 24 alumni participated and 162 students were impacted by the Alumni Insights Panels this year.
- Connected students with two professional associations, the National Association for Environmental Health & Safety and Sustainability Management (NAEM) and the National Association of Environmental Professionals (NAEP).
