Community Conversations

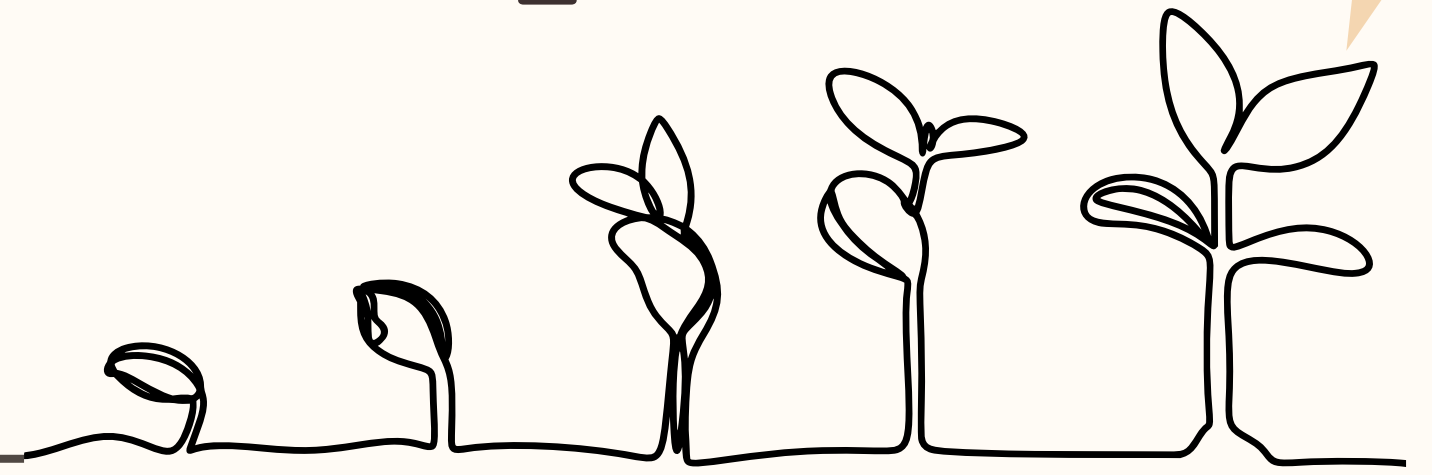
- Facilitated dialogue with peers to deep-dive on a specific topic or question
- RSVP Required
- 1.5 Hour event
- Food provided

Chat & Connects

- Casual opportunity to drop by and talk to peers about a general topic
- Generally lasts around 3 hours- participants are free to come and go
- Light snacks provided

- The event will begin with an icebreaker, followed by an overview of key topics and guiding questions.
- Participants are encouraged to actively engage by asking questions and collaborating toward shared solutions.
- Please arrive at the start to help establish shared agreements and context.
- If you need to leave early, feel free to do so—participate as your schedule allows.

Community Conversations

- Seating will be arranged in a circle to encourage dialogue.
- A facilitator will open with an introduction and invitations for engagement.
- Participants are asked to share openly and engage in difficult conversations with honesty and respect.
- Expect to listen deeply, reflect thoughtfully, and explore differing perspectives.
- Please arrive at the start to help establish shared agreements and context.
- If you need to leave early, feel free to participate as your schedule allows.

Chat & Connects

- A low-stakes, casual space to drop in and connect with peers.
- Conversation will loosely center on the chosen topic, with open and flexible dialogue.
- No formal structure—just an opportunity to build community through conversation.
- Come and go as you please; no RSVP required.
