Sustainability Certificate (residential)

Current opportunities include participation in the Dow Sustainability Fellows Program, Sustainability Without Borders, Blue Lab, Planet Blue, the Campus Farm, sustainability-related internships, or other approved experiential activity. For example, experiential activities could take the form of an intensive international project trip, volunteering at a community organization over the course of a semester, or helping to design and implement a Planet Blue campaign. Given the range of possible activities, experiential activities that are not taken for course credit are evaluated on a case-by-case basis. The suitability of experiences that also fulfill requirements for a graduate degree, such as a required project, departmental capstone course, or research project, is evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Capstone experiences must have a distinct sustainability-related focus and should be approved in advance of the activity.
